Accessible Canvas Pages

This workshop will teach you how to build accessibility into your course at the page level. We will cover Canvas headers, lists, using color, and working with images and video. The same concepts can be used to retrofit existing pages, too. We will wrap up this session by looking at how accessibility checkers, including the one in Canvas, can be used to check accessibility.
